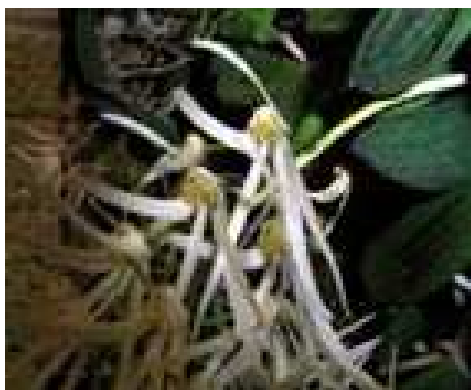

**Flower of First Division and Flower of the Night:** *Cym. Mary Green 'Vivienne'* benched by Sylvester Ng. A well grown plant with seven inflorescences bearing many flowers each. Flowers were 40mm wide and high and were well arranged. Sepals and petals were pale pink on a cream base and the labellum was barred in maroon.



**Flower of Open Division:** *Dock. linguiformis* grown by Noel Oliver. Native to north-east Queensland to south-east New South Wales, the plant was well grown, mounted on a wooden log and bearing some 50 inflorescences with open flowers and more inflorescences still in bud. Flowers were typical for the species, sepals and petals were narrow, about 15mm long, white and pointed at the tip and the tiny labellum reflexed down.



**Flower of Second Division:** *Cym. Mary Green 'Vivienne'* benched by Mari and Daniel Lutz. The plant was reasonably large and carried five inflorescences, flowers being approximately 50mm Across and high. Sepals and petals were pale pink on a cream base with the labellum barred in maroon.
