**SOUTH COAST ORCHID CLUB'S
 SPRING SHOW 1997

Congratulations must go to the Members of the South Coast Orchid Club for their most creditable orchid display at the Marion Shopping complex. Despite the rebuilding and refurbishing going on, and space which had been allocated cut down in size, they did a splendid job.

Cymbidium Wallamurra 'Jupiter' gained Grand Champion for Moss and Rosemary Bray. This well grown and presented cym. bore seven spikes with an average of eleven blooms per raceme, a worthy champion.

For Reserve Champion, and I must say in a very closely run contest, was Dr. Keith Northcote's *Doritaenopsis* Orglades Puff x Phal. (Hakalau Wonder x Hawaiian Snowfall) that displayed eight lovely white flowers which were enhanced by the lip which had a lime-green hue at the throat, side lobes were white with light maroon stripes that added to the appeal of this lovely orchid.

Both these orchids came from Open Division. Champion of First Division was a very well grown *Paphiopedilum*, *hirsutissimum*. This species paph. displayed 6 very nice flowers, congratulations must go to Ron and Irene Parish. From the Second Division, which not only won Champion of the Division but Champion Paphiopedilum as well, was Paph. Pop Monkhouse 'Robie' x Self. This lovely maudiae type paph was a well deserved champ. Only a very small one growth plant but an extremely lovely flower was grown by Helmut Herrmann.

There was a good range and quality of orchids, but regrettably with the restrictions in the display area and renovations, the orchids could not be displayed to their full advantage. Congratulations must go to the workers who did a fantastic job in the face of adversity.

REPOTTING

Repotting of mature cymbidiums should be well under way, if not completed. Don't repot on very hot days.

Use good quality mix that allows for good draining.

Cattleyas can also be repotted now. Many of these have new roots at the base of last years growth. Repot whilst these roots are small as they are easy to damage later.
